Routine Visit

German cockroaches found on the insect detectors in the staff room kitchen, this area has been treated with goliath gel and new insect detectors placed down to monitor their movement.

Mice have been active in the electrical cupboard, one nest removed from this area, light activity on the bait station under the veg rack in the corridor.

All the bait stations previously placed down have been checked, cleaned and refreshed where necessary.

No other activity was found during my visit.
